**PET LICENCES for 2024 are due and are required.** Please notify us of any changes with your pets.

**BUSINESS LICENCES for 2024 are due and are required.** Any out-of-town business or local contractors require a business license, if the contractor does not get a required license the charges will be applied to the home owners taxes.

**BUILDING PERMITS - REMINDER** permits are **REQUIRED** when doing **ANY** renovations or new builds.

**REMINDER:** Please have your garbage bagged and in a CONTAINER by 8:00am Thursday mornings. Any tin cans can be recycled in the metal pile **NOT** in the blue bins **\*\*As of September 1/2024, the Sturgis Landfill will no longer be accepting shingles!\*\***

**LANDFILL** – Compost Pick Up Days are Sept. 12 & 26 & Oct. 10. Compost material must be put in clear bags or garbage cans, if they are not placed in appropriate disposal containers it will not be collected! It will be picked up later in the day after garbage. Compost materials include grass clippings & garden materials. There is a compost pile @ the landfill, ask the landfill supervisor for the location. Ask where tin cans can be put, they do not go in blue bins.

**RECYCLE BINS** – ONLY PAPER, FLATTENED CARDBOARD & RINSED PLASTICS #'s 2-7 LOCATED ON THE BOTTOM OF YOUR CONTAINERS ARE ALLOWED IN BINS. **NO** LEAVES/TWIGS IN THE BLUE BIN!  
THERE ARE CAMERAS AT THE LANDFILL!
