BYLAW NO. 6, 2015

A Bylaw to Regulate the Operation of Snowmobiles within the Town of Sturgis

The council of the Town of Sturgis in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- Under the provisions of The Snowmobile Act and to Sections 2 (1) 3 and 4 of this bylaw a snowmobile may utilize any street, avenue or lane within the Town of Sturgis being the most direct route from residence to the limits of the Town.
- It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the portion of (2)Provincial Highway No. 9 and 49, and Main Street for the purpose of crossing.
- (3) No person shall operate a snowmobile from the corner of Main Street and Railway Avenue to Main Street and Highway 9 & 49.
- (4) A snowmobile may be operated only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. and at a speed not exceeding 40 kilometers per hour.
- Notwithstanding the provisions of this bylaw, the council may, (5)subject to any terms and conditions that the council may impose, issue a permit for a specific snowmobile event.
- The provisions of this bylaw do not apply to a peace officer when (6)engaged in the performance of their duties.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.

Bylaw No. 4/94 is hereby repealed.
