BYLAW NO. 1 - 2025

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STURGIS TO ESTABLISH A RECREATION BOARD

The Council of the Town of Sturgis, in the province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

finition:

- 1. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - a. "Board" means the recreation board appointed pursuant to this bylaw.
 - b. "Council" means the council of the Town of Sturgis.
 - c. "Municipality" means the Town of Sturgis.
 - d. "Program" means those activities normally carried on in culture, recreation and sport.

Function:

- 2. The function of the board shall be:
 - a. To promote the recreational, cultural and sport programs of the community.
 - b. To advise council on projects to improve or extend any of the recreational facilities as required.
- 3. Composition of the Board:
 - a. The board shall be comprised of ten (10) members as follows:
 - Two (2) members appointed by council
 - One (1) Representative from the R.M of Preeceville No 334.
 - One (1) Representative from the Sturgis Composite School
 - One (1) Representative from the seniors Club (READ)
 - Five (5) Representative from the Community at Large
 - (2-year election for each position from the Community at Large)
- 4. The board shall appoint one board member each as:
 - a. Chairperson appointed by board
 - b. Treasurer shall be the Recreation Director
 - c. Secretary shall be the Recreation Director
 - d. Vice Chairperson Appointed by Board

The term of office for each position shall be determined in the first month of each year.

- 5. The seat of a member of the Board who absents himself from three consecutive meetings without authorization by resolution of the Board, shall be declared vacant.
- 6. The seat of a member of the Board shall become vacant upon the receipt of a written notice of resignation by the Secretary of the Board.
- 7. The Recreation Director shall bring to the attention of Council as its next regular meeting any vacancies that might arise.
- 8. The Board shall make recommendations to Council, to fill vacancies, as they arise.
- 9. The Council shall, by resolution, as soon as possible following receipt of the notice of vacancy, fill the vacancy.
- 10. A majority of appointed members shall constitute a quorum.

Meetings:

- 11. The Board shall hold a minimum of six (6) meetings each year, as set by resolution of the Board.
- 12. The secretary of the Board, at the request of the Chairperson or one third of the members, shall call a special meeting at a date specified in the request.
- 13. All meetings of the Board shall be open to the public.
- 14. All members of the Board present shall vote on each question.
- 15. The Chairperson shall preside at all meetings.

- 16. If the Chairperson should be unable to attend the meeting, the Vice Chairperson shall preside.
- 17. All actions of the Board shall be entered in the minute book to be kept for that purpose by the Secretary.
- 18. Following the annual audit, the Treasurer of the Board shall present, for approval, the audited financial statement of the previous year.

Powers and Duties:

- 19. The Board shall establish annual goals and objectives.
- 20. The financial year of the Board shall be calendar year.
- 21. The Recreation Board will oversee distributing all grant money
- 22. The Board may advise Council in all matters placed before it dealing with culture, recreation and sport.
- 23. All volunteers working for the Board shall be considered agents of the municipality.
- 24. The treasurer of the Board shall, at year end, ready the financial records for the audit. The records shall be audited by the municipal auditor.
- 25. The Treasurer of the Board shall deposit all funds to the credit of the Board in a chartered bank or credit union and those funds shall be withdrawn only by cheque signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the Chairperson or the Vice Chairperson.
- 26. The Board may advise or make recommendations to Council with respect to improvements or extensions to the municipal recreation facilities.
- 27. The Board shall access the recreation needs of the residents of the community.
- 28. The Board shall encourage and cooperate with organizations in the promotion of programs.

Bylaw No. 1 - 1988 is hereby repealed

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
