Message from the President Rick Boyles

Greetings friends, and welcome to the March 2023 edition of the Thalia Civic League newsletter. We have made some changes in how the Civic League operates to better communicate and engage with our members and neighbors.

The first change is the newsletter will go out monthly, 12 times a year via email and by posting on the website at www.thalianeighbors.com. The March, June, September and December editions will be printed versions that will be distributed to each of the 850 homes in our area.

The second change is the frequency of meetings. Membership meetings will be held monthly on the third Monday of each month, 12 times a year, so that we do not lose momentum. We will host a guest speaker program with interesting topics for our Membership. This year we have had Delegate Tim Anderson speak about the legislative session that just ended and District 8 Councilman Chris Taylor who spoke and took questions for about 45 minutes on his role as our new City Council representative. The March meeting speaker will be development attorney R.J. Nutter, who is usually found in front of City Council and the Planning Commission representing some of the larger developers in the city. R.J. will answer questions about what residential, multi-family development is going to look like in the future.

The goal of the Officers and Board of Directors is to re-engage the community and generate renewed interest in the Civic League after having lost momentum during the COVID pandemic. We will begin hosting community events, such as the Easter Egg Hunt on April 1, 2023 in the Thalia Park behind New Life Church. Our monthly membership meetings are designed to educate the taxpaying public on issues and initiatives originating from City Council and the Virginia Beach City Government.

It is the job of the Officers and Directors of this organization to answer your question: "What's in it for me?" To achieve those goals, we need your support and engagement. We found during the Venture Realty 'Boulevard at Thalia" apartment project that we can come together as a group and get things done. We want to get the membership back up to the number it was during that period, and we want the Civic League to be your source of information and facts as it relates to City Government. The purpose and mission of your Civic League is to improve the neighborhood and to be the member's voice in City Government and in areas that are "outside the vote". We are well positioned to do those things on your behalf.
