Clintonville Borough, Venango County, PA Meeting Minutes for May 3, 2022, Council Meeting

The monthly meeting of the Clintonville Borough Council was called to order at 6:30 p.m. with President, Becky Hedglin presiding. The meeting was opened with The Pledge of Allegiance and Becky Hedglin said a prayer. Council members present were Mike Sandrock, Sue Sandrock, Becky Hedglin, Jim Bollinger, Cass Bollinger, Ashley Rayl, Wanda Jacobs, and Mayor Megan Weber. Also, present were Mary Kelly, (Tax Collector), Officer Deeter, Aaron Kaylor, Bobbie Francis, Ben Porter, Joe Kelly, and Judy Stoops.

Public Comment - Ben Porter explained about Donaldson Road Bridge replacement and about half of it being owned by Borough. He is applying to several places to get grants to cover cost and hopefully to be replaced in 2023.

Bobbie Francis explained about all the problems that she has encountered to get her father in laws place cleaned up and new place installed. She has felt very frustrated because of all of the harassment she has had. She is asking Borough to vacant the part of Thorn Alley that they have used for many years as a driveway. Once she gets deed back from purchasing Ted Jolley piece of land that borders this, she will bring to Borough, then Borough can proceed with ordinance to vacant alley.
