ORDINANCE No. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDINGS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF CLINTONVILLE

WHEREAS, it is the desire and duty of the Council members of the Borough of Clintonville to provide for the safety and welfare of the Borough and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the numbering of buildings and homes within the Borough will provide for ready identification in the event of fire, police call, or other emergency;

THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted by the Borough of Clintonville, in the County of Venango, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough Council shall make and shall adopt a plan which will cause to number and mark the various buildings, houses, and lots in the Borough of Clintonville. This plan or map shall be deposited and kept with the Secretary of the Borough. The designation of numbers shall be within the sole discretion of the Borough. Notification of assigned numbers shall be given by Council in a manner which will adequately inform the owners.

Section 2. The owner or owners of each house or building shall, within thirty (30) days of receiving notice to do so from Borough Council affix and maintain on his, hers, or their house, or building, in a conspicuous place and in legible, contrasting figures no less than four inches in height, the number or numbers of the said house or building. The owner or owners of any new house or building hereafter

built on any street of the Borough, shall, within thirty (30) days of the completion of the new house or building affix and maintain thereon the number or numbers of the house or building designated by the Borough.

Section 3. Any person or persons refusing or neglecting to comply with the ordinance requiring numbering of houses and buildings shall, upon conviction thereof before the district justice of the peace pay a fine not to exceed \$25.00 for each and every offense, together with costs. In the case of neglect of the owner or owners of any house or building to cause the same to be numbered as herein provided, in addition to the fine, or in lieu thereof, in the discretion of council, the numbering shall be done by a designated person of the Borough Council and the expense thereof together with twenty (20%) percent additional shall be assessed and collected from the owner or owners according to law.

Section 4. The above ordinance shall be effective ten days after its adoption.
