

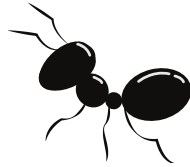
# Animals in the Qur'an

نَمَل



They are usually found on farms. Their stomachs have four compartments and they can drink the amount of a bathtub of water a day!

نَحْل



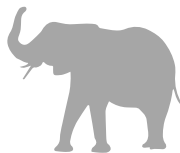
This tiny creature can lift 20 times its own body weight. If a seven-year old was as strong as this creature, they would be able to pick up a car!

بَقَرَةٌ



They have short hairs on their feet that allow them to walk upside down on ceilings and over glass.

فِيل



They are mostly found in Africa and have a roar that can be heard up to 8 kilometres away!

ضِفْدَع



Their wings flap 11,000 times per minute, which is why it sounds like they are "buzzing".

فَسْوْرَةٌ



They are the largest living land animal and can spend up to around 16 hours a day eating!

عَنْكَبُوت



They need to live near water as their skin must constantly be moist. If their skin dries out, they die.
