The Masjid is a very holy place. It is a place where people remember and worship Allah. The word Masjid means, 'a place for prostration (sajdah).'

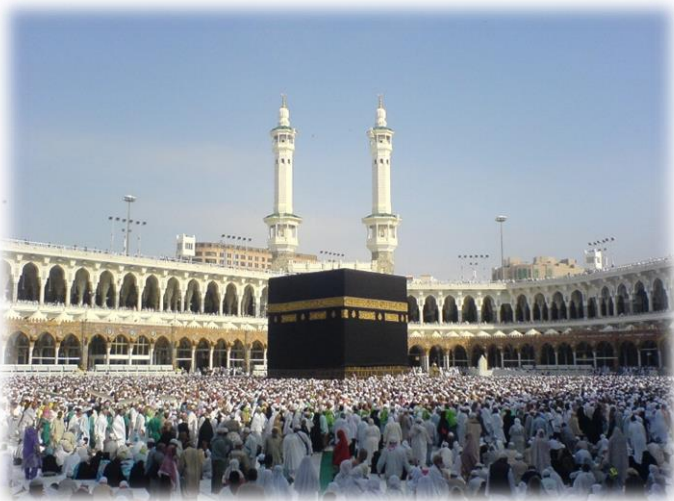
