SNAKES & LADDERS

Character Traits of Muhammad ﷺ

INSTRUCTIONS TO PLAY THE GAME

You will need:

- a dice
- one counter per player
- 2 to 4 players

To play:

- Read about the character and habits of Muhammad ﷺ.
- Each player rolls the dice. The order of turns will be according to the highest number rolled, to the lowest.
- If you land on a snake's head, you go down to the box where the snake's tail ends.
- If you land at the bottom of a ladder, go all the way up the ladder.
- If you land on a question mark, another player picks up a "Question Card" and reads it out to you. In order for your answer to be correct, you must explain or enact the correct response. The outcomes of answering correctly and incorrectly are on the cards.
- The winner is the one who reaches 100 first.

Question Card

What did Muhammad ﷺ ask Ali to do before he left Makkah to go to Madinah?

Answer: a)

- 3) During the Battle of Hunayn, despite the initial confusion, he raised the spirits and courage of his Companions, until they were victorious with the help of Allah.

Explain how Muhammad ﷺ demonstrated honesty during the truce of Hudyibiyah.

Answer:

(Player should include the key points)

An agreement was made that any man who left Muhammad ﷺ would not be returned to him, and any man who left Makkah would be returned to them. Before the treaty was concluded, Abu Jandal had managed to escape from the pagans of Makkah and rushed to join Muhammad ﷺ. He asked Abu Jandal to have patience as they have signed an agreement and we do not betray or act treacherously.
