SEDI-CASE: USVI Winter Economic Summit, Saint Croix on December 07th- 10th, 2023

The Winter Summit seeks to foster and build new economic bridges of International Trade, Commerce, Technology, Banking, Finance & Investments, Tourism (Sports & Health/Wellness/Medical) based on a common history and infrastructures between the United States Virgin Islands, US Mainland, Caribbean/Latin America and Globally.

Leveraging the USVI unique US legislation, policies and regulations economic development authorizations, and the legislation H.R. 4939-United States-Caribbean Strategic Engagement Act of 2016.

This statement of purpose, captures the challenge and the opportunity confronting business and community leaders in the Virgin Islands, including St. Croix. Economic realities include global interaction of the financial markets, inflation costs, and quantum improvements in communications technology. We believe that the US Virgin Islands (USVI) is uniquely positioned to emerge and become one of the region's critically important US international trade/commerce, financial and technology centers. But business and community leaders must conceive the vision and develop the strategies that will enable USVI to turn the potential of this moment into our future reality.

Winter Economic Summit Industry Group Panel Sectors

International Trade & Commerce/Foreign Direct Investments (FDI's) - St. Croix International Free Trade Zone. Applying Public Private Partnership (PPP). A plan to mitigate and facilitate the USA decoupling and onshoring of its critical national and economic security supply chain from China, to the US and closer to the Americas and Caribbean. USVI manufacturing, assembling, warehousing and storage branded made in the USA.

Capital Market Formation- Building on the USVI strong and foundational shared history with New York. New York is the Financial Capital of the World – USVI is positioned to be the gateway for companies throughout the Americas, Caribbean and globally looking to do business with the United States, and gaining better access to the US capital markets. USVI has 14 designated Opportunity Zones.

Transportation and Maritime (USVI Jones Act Exemption) - Free Trade Zone, 100 percent HUBZone.

Airport Infrastructure- VIPA Cyril E. King Airport & Henry E. Rohlsen International Airports modernization. Opportunities to connect St. Croix's Henry E. Rohlsen International Airport and Stewart International Airport (Newburgh, NY) to relieve international freight congestion at LaGuardia, JFK & Newark Airports. Smart City Supply Chain Center of Regional Excellence (SCcORE) at New York International Plaza (NYIP). Being integrated into the WTC Frederiksted hosting the Cybersecurity and data interoperability in Saint Croix.

Innovation Technology- USVI is an emerging tech hub - UVI Research and Technology Park (construction of 40-million-dollar tech village) and world class telecommunication fiber optic network subsea cable network that provides high-speed internet to Europe, South America, North America, and the Caribbean- St. Croix is home to the South America Connection (SAC) "connects" New York/Florida and USVI because two of their largest networks are in Brookhaven, NY and Frederiksted, St. Croix.

Workforce Development - Collaboration and cooperation between the USVI academia (with other regional colleges and universities tech startup incubators), SEDI-CASE: CASE Study & StartUp VI (US Mainland, Caribbean/Latin America, and Taiwan) in the area of research and development (R&D), education, workforce development and training of ethnic minority and women, in addressing closing the disparity gap in industries like financial services, technology (Fintech, Cybersecurity, Semiconductors, Smart City IoT etc).

Travel & Tourism - New strategic collaborative markets and branding opportunities through health, wellness, medical, sports, gastronomy (food) tourism, and the creative economy. St. Croix is now one the US 62 rare and newly designated National Heritage Area gems.

Our Solution:

USVI's best and brightest leaders must collectively come together to seize the opportunity to define the vision and create sustainable economic development. Apply a public private partnership (P3) approach with Governor Albert Bryan Jr (Bryan-Roach Administration), Vision 2040 Plan to meet the goals and objectives of the 2023 Winter Economic Summit.
