To date, the hospital has served over 100,000 patients and performed more than 24,000 surgeries, with over 80% of treatments provided free or at subsidized rates, embodying our mission to make advanced eye care accessible to all.














Attock Chapter


OPD Services Are Here!

Future Plans


Immediate Plan
