PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE STATE BOARD EXAMINATION IS GIVEN DAILY.
Once you have completed all your requirements (which includes passing the ABO Exam), you can apply to take the Arkansas State Board of Dispensing Opticians Licensed Exam. Once the application is approved you can schedule to take the exam at a testing service. Most testing services are open Mon-Sat 8 am 7 pm

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY IF YOU DO NOT SENT A COPY OF YOUR HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT WITH YOUR APPRENTICE OR LICENSE APPLICATION, OR YOU DO NOT COMPLETE THE APPLICATION CORRECTLY, IT WILL BE RETURNED TO YOU FIRST CLASS MAIL. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!

Exciting News! The board has updated all forms, as of January 1, 2025 only the new forms will be accepted

APPRENTICE OPTICIANS REMEMBER

You may not work alone, you must have direct personal physical supervision, by a Licensed or Registered Optician at all times.

Licensed opticians can supervise 3 apprentice opticians at one time. Remember you MUST be able to give them supervision at ALL times The board is now a part of the department of health and lots of changed have happened, so make sure you have the correct information about apprentice applications, license applications, office permit applications, renewals, and testing process.

2025-2026 RENEWAL FEE WILL BE \$3.00 IF PAID BEFORE JUNE 10, 2025. FEE WILL GO BACK TO \$60.00 PLUS LATE FEE IF PAID AFTER JUNE 10.

OFFICE PERMITS due June 10 and the fee is \$60. Dispensers MUST be sure that the office they work in has a valid office permit. **It is illegal to work in an office that does not have a current office permit.**
