The Fee will be \$60.00 and the late fee will apply

When you have a new apprentice applying for an apprenticeship they MUST ENCLOSE:

- . A transcript High School or college stating the date they graduated
- A supervision agreement
- On the Section, Current Business, they must fill out the Optical information of where they are
 going to serve their apprenticeship. The board office has received several applications for
 Apprenticeship that do not have the required business information. They must have a job as an
 apprentice before applying.
