(Parents of Children under 13 years old attending Winter Creek Reunion)

Winter Creek Reunion welcomes you and your family. We look forward to ensuring that you and your family have a learning, enjoyable, and safe stay during the camping/jam. To make sure that happens Red River Valley Dulcimer Club has discovered that we need to put a few guidelines in place.

- WCR is located on a working farm, so please respect the property and stay within designated camping and festival grounds. This particularly is important for the little ones under 13. There are too many dangers on a farm to allow the wandering of children off the festival grounds. This year we will be marking festival grounds by orange fencing. Please respect the boundaries of the festival grounds.
- You as parents are responsible for the safety of your child. They need to always be with you or with a mature, responsible person over 13. If your child goes off festival property you will be asked to depart festival grounds due to lack of supervision. We suggest a babysitter with large families to help facilitate supervision if necessary.
- WCR is designed to focus on music and learning. We asked that children contain their playing to the marked area outside the festival area. Let's keep the workshop, vendor, and barn for festival enjoyment. The back porch is for jams and the house is a private residence and off limits and is not a play area for children.
- Concerts and workshops are so much more enjoyable if cell phones and voices are quieted. So please be mindful of that. We ask that children in the camping area also be mindful of the amount of noise during play.
