



CHILD SAFE VISITS CODE OF CONDUCT NON-CUSTODIAL PARENT

PLEASE READ AND INITIAL EACH ITEM

- I agree to follow all court orders as well as the monitor's code of conduct.
- Drugs and Alcohol will not be consumed 12 hours before or during visitations. It is understood that visits will be cancelled if drugs or alcohol is suspected to have been used prior to the start of a visit.
- I agree to arrive on time at the exchange site arranged by the monitor or the court and leave immediately after the visit has ended. Following, gesturing to, or harassing the custodial parent is prohibited.
- Third-party guests will not be allowed to attend visits for the first TWO sessions.
Any guests/other visitors MUST be pre-approved by monitor and will be subject to the same code of conduct during visitations. An agreement MUST be signed by adult guests/visitors before the start of visit.
- Weapons are not allowed at **ANY** visit or exchange.
- Negative conversations about custodial parent, to visiting child(ren), is strictly prohibited.
- Adult issues will NOT be discussed with child(ren), including but not limited to: court proceedings, living arrangements, relationship status, etc.
- The child(ren) will not be used as a messenger. Nor shall written or verbal messages be relayed through the child(ren).
- The use of corporal punishment or threatening to use physical punishment during visits is not allowed.
- Social Media photos/recordings and postings are prohibited during visits.
- Cancellation of a visit without proper notice will be subject to a cancellation fee.
- Visitation Monitors are mandated by the court to report ANY circumstance that compromises the child(ren)'s health, safety or welfare. Including but not limited to general neglect, sexual abuse, physical abuse, the threat of violence against the child or custodial parent.
- I understand that in the event the Primary Monitor is unavailable, I agree to a qualified Substitute Monitor in his/her place.
- It is understood that any violation of this code of conduct can result in the termination of visitation services.

Any requests for reports must be made in writing and submitted 14 days prior to court hearings; reports will not be started unless payment is received in full. *An additional fee will be added if proper notice is not given.
