Finding a Committee Page

- Click on “Committees” **tab** in the menu bar
- Links to different types of Committees, such as **Joint and Study Committees** are located on the right side of the webpage.



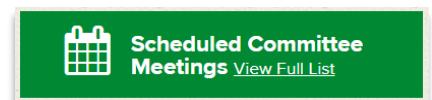
What you will find on a Committee Page:

- Current and past meeting agendas
- Livestream (YouTube) link
- Documents, handouts and reports from attorneys and witnesses that pertain to bills that the committee has taken in information/testimony on.
- Bills in and out of Committee
- List of witnesses who have submitted documents or reports.

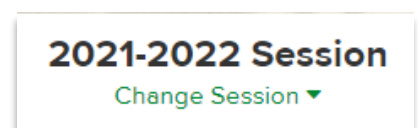
House & Senate Schedule and Agendas (Calendars):

Bills, Resolutions and Acts

Finding Bills, Resolutions and Acts

1. Click on the Bills and Resolutions **tab** in the menu bar
2. Click on the appropriate category, or
3. Click on Bill, Act & Resolution **Search** (left-hand menu)
4. For previous sessions, use the “Change Session” pull down menu in the upper left-hand corner of the page.

Legislator Information

Finding Legislators

1. From the search bar at the top of every page, click on Legislator.
2. Type in the name of the Legislator you are looking for in the search box. Alternatively, click on the House or Senate tab, and click on “**Find Representatives or Find Senators**”. You can also search by town.
3. Find the Legislator’s **District Map** by clicking on the County name listed at the top of the Legislator’s page.

Email Access, Time Reporting, Expense Reporting

Member and Staff Links

At the bottom of each webpage there is a menu with additional links:

- **Email Access** – Clicking this takes you to a web-based version of your Legislative email account. This allows you to have access to your Leg email anytime you have access to the internet. ***The online version of your email account also allows you access to your Archived Emails (emails are archived after 180 days).***
- **Time Reporting** – Use this link to access your Timesheet and HR benefit reports.
- **Expense Reporting** – Use this link to report your Legislative expenses.
