BETTE CANO COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: 2.0 GPA and demonstrate a commitment to their community through Riverside University High School, community, or church activities. *Award: \$500*

DREW/WASHABAUGH FAMILY AND FRIENDS SCHOLARSHIPS: Requirements: 2.5 GPA, must attend a Wisconsin college, university or 2-year college, and must document a plan for funding their education. *Award: \$2000*

FOUNDATION GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: 2.5 GPA. Financial need, participation in school activities and community service will be considered. *Award: \$1000*

JIM GIBSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: 2.5 GPA and held a leadership role in the school and/or the community. Financial need, participation in school activities and community service will be considered. *Award: \$2000*

SCHOLAR ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must have participated in a RUHS athletic team, have a minimum 2.5 GPA, demonstrate financial need, and have done some community service. *Award: \$1000*

TABAK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must be from a single parent home and have a 2.5 GPA. Financial need, participation in school activities and community service will be considered. *Award: \$1000*

THORNBURG SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must plan to pursue a career in education. *Award: \$1000*

TOM WILD LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must be able to articulate about the legacy the applicant has passed on to RUHS. Academic achievement, student activity, community service and financial need will be considered. *Award: \$1000*

TOWERVIEW INVESTMENT INCENTIVE TO GRADUATE: Requirements: Must have immigrated to the United States, must have English as a second language, and must be a first-generation family member to attend college. *Award: One 4 year renewable, increasing award- first year \$1000, second year \$2000, third year, \$3000, fourth year, \$4000*

TOWERVIEW COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must have immigrated to the United States, have English as a second language and/or be the first-generation family member to attend college. *Award: \$1000*

WALDNER-CORNELL FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must be planning a career in public service, have a 3.0 GPA and good attendance. Extra value placed on volunteer community service work during high school. *Award: \$2000*

WERNER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Requirements: Must have a 3.0 GPA, must have been an active participant in school activities, must have demonstrated a commitment to serving community and must have a financial need. *Award: \$2000*
