BETTE CANO COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP: Must demonstrate a commitment to their community through Riverside University High School, community, or church activities. Award: \$500

BEZELLA FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Must have an interest in pursuing studies and a career in science, technology, engineering, or math. One \$5000 renewable scholarship for a four-year college **or** one \$2000 renewable scholarship for a two-year college.

BRIN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Must plan on attending a Wisconsin school. Award: \$3000

NANCY S. CONNER-McDONALD SCHOLARSHIP: Must be an African American male and plan on attending UW-Whitewater or UW-Milwaukee. Award: \$2000

DREW/WASHABAUGH FAMILY AND FRIENDS SCHOLARSHIP: Must plan on attending a University of Wisconsin school and must document a plan for funding their education. Award: \$2500

FOUNDATION GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP: Must be a Riverside senior. Award: \$1000

JIM GIBSON MEMORIAL SCHOLASHIP: Must have held a leadership role in the school and/or the community. Award: \$2000

PAT & JOAN KERNS SCHOLARSHIP: Must be a senior lettered basketball player and active in extra-curriculars. Award: \$1500

MIKE NOWICKI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: Must have been a member of the Swim team for two years and active in extracurriculars. Award \$1500

SCHOLAR ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP: Must have participated in a RUHS athletic team and have done some community service. Award: \$1000

THORNBURG SCHOLARSHIP: Must plan to pursue a career in education. Award: \$1000

TOWERVIEW SCHOLARSHIP: Must have immigrated to the United States, have English as a second language and/or be the first-generation family member to attend college. Award: \$1000

WASHABAUGH FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Must be African American and planning on attending UWM. Award: \$2500 for three semesters

WALDNER-CORNELL FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Must be planning a career in public service. Award: \$2000

WERNER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: Must have a 3.0 GPA, must have been an active participant in school activities, and must have demonstrated a commitment to serving the community. Award: \$2000 renewable for four years

TOM WILD LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP: Must be able to articulate about the legacy the applicant has passed on to RUHS. Award: \$2000

FLORENCE YARNEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: Ms. Yarney was a beloved Riverside English teacher who had a unique ability to lift students up so they could realize their potential. Be able to explain how you have encouraged others to live their best lives. Award: \$2000
