This is an Old Testament story from Exodus, the second book of the Bible. This story happened about 400 years after last month's stories about Joseph. His family grew so large that Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, made them his slaves. He was worried the Israelites (Joseph's family) would take over his country.

Remember: God had a plan for Moses' life. God has a plan for our lives, too. God told Moses that he would always be with him. God is always with us, too. *

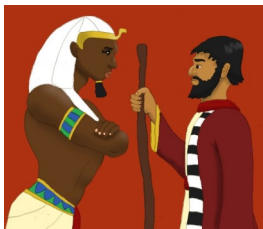
