Goliath was more than 9 feet tall! He wore a bronze suit of armor, covering him from head to toe. His armor alone weighed more than 100 pounds. Using a tape measure or your family's growth chart, determine each others' heights. If you stood on each other's shoulders, would you be Goliath's height? Could you carry 100 pounds?

Preschool families may try special activities here.

Watch this video of boys singing and pretending to be David. Learn the song and sing with them.

How did David's shepherding skills prepare him to face the giant, Goliath? Who or what are some "giants" you face in your life? How does God help you face them?

Read these stories about brave children.

Pray with thanksgiving for those whom God calls to face the world's giants. Ask God to be with you every day, teaching you, and preparing you to do great things.
