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Jesus Resurrected

Easter is not just a day; it is a whole season of our Christian year. Easter lasts 50 days (until Pentecost). Use these activities to reflect on Christ's resurrection through the month of April.

Each of the 4 Gospels ("good news") tells the story of Jesus' resurrection slightly different from one another. Read the story from the Bible or Children's Bible Story Book or online. What is the "good news" in this story?

Older children may enjoy Learning the history of Easter symbols and traditions.

Watch this animated <u>movie</u> based on the folktale *Tale of Three Trees*. Say a prayer of thanksgiving that God created YOU and uses you in a special way.

Butterflies are common symbols of Easter. Learn about their lifecycle <u>here</u>. How is this similar to Jesus' resurrection? Create a <u>butterfly garland</u> and decorate your room. Visit the Bronx Zoo or Riverhead Aquarium to see butterflies growing.
