Weather Update - Rain Delays in May

May has been particularly challenging due to frequent rain—about 11 rainy days so far, many falling on our scheduled mowing days. While we're eager to catch up as soon as the weather allows, we assess each lawn carefully after rain to ensure it's safe and beneficial to mow.

Why we delay mowing wet lawns:

- Wet grass bends easily, resulting in uneven cuts.
- Mowing on wet soil can compact it, hindering root growth and nutrient absorption.
- Damp conditions increase the risk of spreading lawn diseases from lawn to lawn.
- Wet grass clogs mower decks and discharge chutes, straining our equipment and causing corrosion.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we balance timely service with protecting your lawn's health and maintaining our equipment.
