#### **Real Estate Snapshot**

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports for the month of July 2022:

During the first seven months of 2022, 3,833 homes were sold in York County, a 4% decrease from this time last year.

The median home sale price for all of York County is \$241,000, an 11% increase from this time in 2021.

Southeastern York County median sales price in April 2022 is \$296,950 up 12% from this time last year.

#### **Real Time September Listings Snapshot**

A search of active listings in Stewartstown, Shrewsbury, Glen Rock, New Freedom, Red Lion and Dallastown, shows 136 homes for sale as of September 10, 2022. Stewartstown boasts the lion's share of available homes at 52. In contrast, Shrewsbury, Glen Rock and New Freedom each have 12 homes on the market.

#### **Housing Market Food for Thought**

Elle Hale, 2022 RAYAC President says "The real estate market has had a small shift in York County. With the rise in interest rates over 5%, the number of home sales in York County has a small decline year to date compared to 2021. It is important to keep in mind that 2021 was an exceptional year breaking the record of the number of home sales ever recorded in York County. The median home sale price continues to rise. According to our predictions, the median home sale price will continue to increase in York & Adams Counties through 2023."

## **Fall Lawn Care in Southern York County PA**

#### Aeration – Early to mid-spring or late summer to early fall

Aeration is the process of creating holes in a lawn to alleviate soil compaction reduce thatch, while allowing a better flow of oxygen, water, and nutrients to roots. It allows the grass roots to dig deep into the soil which allows for strong and resilient growth.

## Seeding – Late summer to early fall is best for establishing a new lawn from seed

In general, new lawns are more successful when there is less weed competition and new grass will have 2 seasons of cool weather to establish before encountering the stress of summer heat.

#### Overseeding – Late winter, spring, or early fall

Aeration prior to overseeding in spring or early fall provides seed the soil contact and space needed to germinate and develop successfully

## <u>Fertilization</u> – Mid to late spring and/or late summer to early fall

Annual applications of nitrogen fertilizers can help maintain good quality lawns and, in some cases, improve lawns that need a quality boost.

## <u>Sodding</u> – Just about any time of year, but try to avoid the hottest, driest parts of summer

Sod can be placed any time of year when temperatures are cooler, and rainfall or watering opportunities are more plentiful.

## <u>Liming</u> – Fall or early winter

Soil PH should generally fall between 6.0 and 7.0 in our area. If soil is too acidic, apply lime based on a soil test recommendation. You can obtain a test kit online from Penn State: <a href="http://agsci.psu.edu/aasl/soil-testing/soil-fertility-testing">http://agsci.psu.edu/aasl/soil-testing/soil-fertility-testing</a> The cost for the sample kit is about \$9.00 and, once submitted and analyzed, recommendations for liming and fertilization will be sent to you.

## Weed Control – Between March 15 and April 15

The best weed control is a dense, properly managed lawn. The lawn care suggestions above will help achieve that goal. Even so, sometimes weeds can still emerge. When this happens, the use of preemergent herbicides can control annual weeds such as crabgrass if they're applied prior to weed seed germination near the dates listed.

## Things to Do Now to Get Your Home's Exterior Ready for Fall

- If early spring flowering bulbs such as tulips, daffodils, and crocuses are going to be part of your 2023 garden, look for bulbs that are winter hardy in USDA hardiness zones 5 to 7, which most fall bulbs are.
  - Plant bulbs in full sun and rich, well-draining soil before the first frost.
  - Dig a hole that is 2 to three times as wide as the bulbs, making sure the soil is well turned. Cover with 2 5 inches of mulch.
- Leaves, leaves, and more leaves! A heavy layer of leaves on the lawn or in the garden can smother grass and plants and prevent spring growth. It's a good idea to get rid of leaves once the trees are mostly bare.
- Weeding the garden! A final weeding of your garden in the fall can help prevent weeds from going to seed, which, in turn, will produce hundreds of new weeds in the spring next year.
- If fall rain has the lawn growing, it's a good idea to do a final mowing at about
   3.25 inches so it's ready for spring next year.
- Power wash siding and walkways.
- Wash exterior windows and doors before it gets too cold.

## **Interesting Facts About Fall**

- The official first day of Fall is on Thursday, September 22, 2022, and gives way to Winter on Wednesday, December 21, 2022, in the northern hemisphere. In the southern hemisphere temperate zone, spring begins on September 1, summer on December 1, fall on March 1 and winter on June 1. The countries that make up the southern hemisphere are below the equator. Africa, Asia, Antarctica, Oceania/Australia and New Zealand, and South America are continents in the southern hemisphere.
- Americans typically refer to this season ad "fall" while the British use the word "autumn". Prior to the 16<sup>th</sup> century, it was referred to as "harvest".
- Leaves change colors in the fall due to the temperatures dropping and the days becoming shorter when trees get less direct sunlight. As a result, the chlorophyll in the leaves breaks down, revealing yellow and orange pigments. They were already there, just masked during the warmer months. Once chlorophyll is lost, the leaves can't make food in the form of photosynthesis, so the leaves die and fall from trees.
- There are more than 7,500 apple varieties grown around the globe and approximately 2,500 types grown in the US.
- It has been reported that Halloween is ranked as the second largest commercial in the country with Christmas being the first. Americans spent about \$9 billion on Halloween in 2019, and even with COVID, still forked over about \$8 billion.

#### All Around the House

- Wipe down the walls and clean baseboards
- Change the furnace filter
- Wash the windows, windowsills, and the window and sliding door grooves
- Remove, clean and store (if possible), window screens
- Wash curtains
- Clean doors, and don't forget to disinfect doorknobs
- Disinfect light switches and light switch plates
- Dust the tops of doors and doorframes
- Clean the floors under area rugs
- Vacuum upholstered furniture
- Dust ceiling fans and set them to turn so air circulates upward
- Clean kitchen and bathroom grout
- Clean the inside of the refrigerator
- Clean and condition wood kitchen and bathroom cabinets
- Replace filmy shower curtain liners
- Clean bathroom light fixtures
- Clean and disinfect waste cans
