Real Estate Snapshot

The REALTORS[®] Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) **August 2023** Housing Statistics report indicates:

In York County, 3,561 homes were sold during the first eight months of 2023, a 20% decrease from this time last year.

The median home sale price for all of York County was \$263,900, an 8% increase from this time last year.

RAYAC's school district statistics comparison between January 1 to August 31 2023-2022 indicates the 2023 median sales price in South Eastern York County School District increased 12% to \$335,000 from \$300,000 in the same time-period in 2022. The number of homes sold in the school district decreased by 13%, from 193 to 168.

In the Southern York School district, median home sale price increased by 1%, from \$327,000 to \$330,000. By the end of August 2023, 169 homes were sold, whereas 199 were sold by this time in 2022, a decrease of 15%.

In August 2023 in all of York County, new listings numbered 625, bringing the total listings to 732. On average, days on the market in August was 6 and 100% received List Price.

Reid Weinbrom, 2023 RAYAC President says, "The continuous shortage of available housing inventory, coupled with strong buyer demand, consistently impacts sales prices, leading many sellers to receive multiple offers shortly after listing their properties."

Lawn Care Calendar for Southern York County PA

Aeration – Early to mid-spring or late summer to early fall

This service is provided by Extend Your Day, LLC – Call or text Cory for a free estimate

Aeration is the process of creating holes in a lawn to alleviate soil compaction reduce thatch, while allowing a better flow of oxygen, water, and nutrients to roots. It allows the grass roots to dig deep into the soil which allows for strong and resilient growth.

Seeding – Late summer to early fall is best for establishing a new lawn from seed

This service is provided by Extend Your Day, LLC – Call or text Cory for a free estimate

In general, new lawns are more successful when there is less weed competition and new grass will have 2 seasons of cool weather to establish before encountering the stress of summer heat.

Overseeding – Late winter, spring, or early fall

This service is provided by Extend Your Day, LLC - Call or text Cory for a free estimate

Aeration prior to overseeding in spring or early fall provides seed the soil contact and space needed to germinate and develop successfully

Fertilization – Mid to late spring and/or late summer to early fall

Annual applications of nitrogen fertilizers can help maintain good quality lawns and, in some cases, improve lawns that need a quality boost.

<u>Sodding</u> – Just about any time of year, but try to avoid the hottest, driest parts of summer

Sod can be placed any time of year when temperatures are cooler, and rainfall or watering opportunities are more plentiful.

Liming – Fall or early winter

Soil PH should generally fall between 6.0 and 7.0 in our area. If soil is too acidic, apply lime based on a soil test recommendation. You can obtain a test kit online from Penn State: http://agsci.psu.edu/aasl/soil-testing/soilfertility-testing The cost for the sample kit is about \$9.00 and, once submitted and analyzed, recommendations for liming and fertilization will be sent to you.

Weed Control – Between March 15 and April 15

The best weed control is a dense, properly managed lawn. The lawn care suggestions above will help achieve that goal. Even so, sometimes weeds can still emerge. When this happens, the use of preemergent herbicides can control annual weeds such as crabgrass if they're applied prior to weed seed germination near the dates listed.

Fall in Pennsylvania is 89.8 consecutive days beginning on Saturday, September 23, 2023, until the first day of winter on Thursday, December 21, 2023.

Fall Color Predictions

Several sources indicate the most sensational fall foliage in Pennsylvania will be during the week of October 16 in the eastern, southern, and western parts of the state. Check out smokymountains.com for an interactive Fall foliage prediction map as well as some of the science behind autumn leaves changing their color.

As of August 16, 2023, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) has increased the likelihood of an above-normal Atlantic hurricane season to 60% from the original May outlook which was a 30% chance. For a hurricane to form, there needs to be warm water, moist air, and converging winds.

Fall Home Maintenance Checklist

Consider these home maintenance chores before the temperatures drop.

Seal air leaks

 Find and seal drafts throughout your home. Check the caulk and/or weatherstripping around doors and windows. As an alternative, use a heavy-duty, clear plastic sheet taped to the inside of the window frames to reduce drafts.

Check your roof

 Look for potential signs of a roof leak such as water spots on ceilings or walls, missing, cracked or damaged shingles, missing or damaged flashing, or wet spots and/or wet roof decking in the attic.

Clean your gutters and downspouts

 To prevent stormwater from finding its way inside your home make sure the gutters and downspouts are not clogged. This home maintenance chore can be tedious and dangerous, especially when using a ladder. Stepladders are prone to tipping if you get off balance. A sturdy extension ladder with someone standing at the base to stabilize the ladder is recommended. Hiring a professional is another way to take care of clogged gutters and downspouts.

Protect outside faucets from freezing temperatures

 Take steps before winter to make sure your outside faucets don't freeze and burst. Close any shut-off valves for the outside faucets. Once that's done, open the outside faucet to drain the line. If there aren't any shut-off valves, you could try outdoor faucet covers found online or at a hardware store.

Perform general safety checks

• Not a complete list by any means. Make sure your chimney is clean and safe to use, have your yearly furnace check performed, insulate exposed pipes to prevent freezing, and check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.

Prepare your lawn and gardens for winter

 Removing leaves, aerating, and overseeding is done in the fall to prep your lawn for spring. The Lawn Care Calendar for Southern York County on page 4 of this newsletter is a helpful guide to determine which lawn services during the year you may want to perform or schedule.

Cleaning with Vinegar

Vinegar is an inexpensive disinfectant, deodorizer, and degreaser.

Glass Shower Doors with Hard Water or Soap Scum Stains

In a spray bottle, mix 1-part white vinegar with 1-part Dawn dish soap. Spray on glass door and either close it or put an old towel under it to collect drips. Use a cloth to scrub the surface after about 20 – 30 minutes. Dry completely.

Showerhead

You can remove hard water build-up from your bathroom showerhead by slowly mixing 1/3 cup of baking soda and 1 cup of white vinegar in a gallon size bag. Attach the liquid-filled bubbling bag around the showerhead using rubber bands, let it soak overnight then use a clean cloth to remove any remaining cleaning residue and wash the showerhead clean.

Microwave

Pour about 2 inches of vinegar into a microwave safe bowl. Heat for 2 minutes. The vinegar will steam clean the inside of the microwave. Remove the bowl and use a dry cloth to easily wipe the inside of the microwave clean.

Washing Machine

PLEASE NOTE: Bleach and vinegar should never be mixed when cleaning. This cleaning information is 2 separate steps!

<u>Step 1:</u> Use a diluted bleach solution to pre-treat the inside of your washing machine and run it through a full cycle.

<u>Step 2:</u> In a separate cycle, repeat the process with diluted vinegar to leave the inside of your washing machine completely clean.

Bath Towels

When bath towels start to feel scratchy, it's easy to fluff them up. Use ½ cup of white vinegar in the fabric softener dispenser when you run them through the laundry.

Grilling Utensils

Keep grilling tools clean during use by keeping a cloth dampened with white vinegar nearby as you grill. It's an easy way to disinfect thermometer probes and utensils that touch meat while cooking at the same time.
