## Care and use instructions

### Cleaning

Use non abrasive cleaners like Windex or LA's Awesome cleaners for showers and countertops.

Don't use scrub pads or abrasives of any kind. These can dull your finish over time.

### Scratches

Everything scratches, stone, or Epoxy. Your counter has a hardness coating which is very durable and with enough force it is possible to damage it.

Some things to remember...

- Use a cutting board when slicing and dicing anything on your counter.
- Don't use scrub pads or abrasives of any kind. These can dull your finish over time.
- Heavy objects may indent your counter when its less than a month old. These dents will go away slowly once the object is removed. Once the epoxy has fully cured (30 to 60 days) this won't be a problem.
