RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Parade units are allowed to have individuals walk alongside a parade unit and distribute candy, flags, coupons, or merchandise to spectators along the parade route as long as they are adjacent to the spectators. **Please do not throw the items.**
- Due to the time limit of the parade, <u>All Parade Units must not stop</u> during the Parade Route. Walking maneuvers, dance routines, and etc. are allowed only if they do not slow the pace of the parade.
- 3. Parade units must stay in their assigned areas. Do not disturb other units by walking in and through other units during the parade.
- 4. Marching units will consist of High School and College Bands, Military Units, Adult Civic Club Groups, and Other Marching Participating Groups.
- 5. The Black Heritage Society and the City of Houston assumes no responsibility for accidents by any participant. If entering a vehicle, specialty or antique car or truck, proof of current liability insurance coverage for the specific parade vehicle is required upon application approval.
