~License holders 69 and younger may now qualify for online renewal.

~License holders over the age of 70 will receive an automatic extension valid for one year from the expiration date (for licenses expiring before 12/31/20).

A PROPER PLAN

- Durable Power of Attorney - In the event of incapacity, the person you designate will pay your bills and take care of personal financial matters.
- Pour-Over Will - If there are assets not vested in the name of your Trust, at your death, a pour-over Will ensures that they are distributed to your Trust.
- Certification of Trust - This can be provided to institutions and individuals to add assets to the Trust now and in the future.
- Transfer of real property to your Trust and guidance on transferring your personal property into the name of your Trust.
