- Five-minute tack change allowed if notified to the announcers booth.
- NO ONE under the age of 18 may show a Stallion.
- The Show Committee has the right to combine, cancel or divide a class when necessary.
- The Show Committee has the right to refuse check or issue tabs. A \$50 charge on all returned checks.
- Entries are non-refundable.
- The Horse Show is not liable for theft, accident or injury to rider, equipment or horse.

The Show is designed to be educational, fun and may be financially rewarding.

- Cash awards to all first place and high point winners.
- All ribbon winners are eligible to win a \$100 cash prize. Drawing at end of show. You must be present. No Stand-ins please.
