- Bring return address/computer labels one per item to be placed on entry tags.
- Each item should have a label with complete information for each Section and Class per example below. Do not put your name on entries.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Entries earning a 1st or 2nd place ribbon will be sold at auction. All non-winning entries will be sold in the Ladies Fair building following the auction.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & JUDGING CRITERIA

- All entries should be clean and blemish free. Loose items must be contained in an appropriately sized box, basket, etc. Entries will be judged partially on presentation.
- Not all entries will be awarded a ribbon. Judges' decisions are final.
- Prize money will be awarded after Saturday's auction in the Office (S.E. corner of lunch stand) at approximately 3:30 PM. Prize money not picked up by 4 PM on Sunday will be considered a donation and will not be forwarded by mail.
- The Fair Management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any entry exhibited.
