Atlanta Says Goodbye (Sort of) to Sprawl

Over the past few years a majority of new development in the Atlanta metro area has been of denser, pedestrian-centric type neighborhoods that are more common in Northeast cities, suggesting that the suburban-type development has started to wane even in the most auto-centric places, according to a report released this week by Christopher Leinberger, a developer and professor at the George Washington University School of Business in Washington D.C.
