Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

CLOSING DATE

April 8, 2026

Daily adds/scratches are due in the show office by 4pm the day before the class, unless otherwise noted.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, dis-

qualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

WARNING: THE AIKEN CHARITY HORSE SHOW AT BRUCE'S FIELD, IT'S MANAGEMENT, OFFICERS, OWNERS, OFFICIALS, AND EMPLOYEES WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT OR LOSS WHICH MAY OCCUR TO AN EXHIBITOR, SPECTATOR, GUEST, RIDER, GROOM, ATTENDANT OR OTHER EMPLOYEE, ANIMAL, VEHICLE, OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

USEF/ USHJA DRUG FEES

Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$10.00 USEF fee. (Total \$25.00 USEF Fee). Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Zone Support fee of \$10.00.

DISCLAIMER

While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, USEF, The Aiken Horse Park, AHPF, and its management and/ employees assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

CREDENTIALS

ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDENTIALS (MEASUREMENT CARD OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATION) TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Anyone not presenting valid membership credentials with USHJA will be charged a \$30.00 non-refundable show pass fee. Amateur exhibitors not able to present valid Amateur Credentials will be required to join the Federation. USEF Show Pass Fee must be purchased from USEF before the start of the show.

GROUND'S FEE

All horses must be entered in the show and be issued a back number. Any horse not paying the show stall fee will be charged a grounds fee of \$60.

AMBULANCE FEE

An ambulance fee of \$35 will be charged per horse. This fee helps to defray the cost of medical personnel, an ambulance and the horse ambulance and safety personnel.





HORSE REGISTRATION

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA.

A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Proof of registration must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be released. To be eligible for National, Regional or Zone Horse of the Year Awards, and to enter a USEF Computer Ranking List Class horses must also be registered with the USEF.

ENTRIES

The closing date for entries for the Aiken Charity Horse Show is April 8, 2026. After this dates stall fees are non-refundable. A \$50 late fee will apply for all entries not received by these dates. Entries should be made online via horseshowsonline.com. Checks should be made payable to AHPF **Numbers WILL NOT be issued without a SIGNED OPEN CHECK or CREDIT CARD INFORMATION lodged with the Horse Show Secretary.** A \$75 Office/Service Fee will be charged to each horse to cover adds/scratches, office services, etc. A \$75 Office/Service Fee will be charged to each horse to cover adds/scratches, office services, etc. Please note; a \$150 fine plus collection fees will be charged for non-negotiable checks.

The entry form for each show must include the following:

- Horse name and complete description;
- All classes or divisions entered;
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibiting;
- Organization membership numbers;
- Social Security or Federal ID number of owner or prize money alternate payee.

STALLS

Permanent 10 X 12 stalls of wood/metal construction with doors and mats are available during the event at a cost of \$375 per horse/pony. Temporary 10'x10' stalls are \$350 with grass flooring will be assigned as needed. Stalls will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. All stalls are non-transferable and remain under the control of AHPE. Management reserves the right to limit availability of tack stalls based on numbers of horses entered, you will be notified by April 8th if we can not accommodate the full number of tack stalls requested. A \$50 early arrival fee will be charged per entry.

- Trainer/ Entries with fewer than 3 showing horses may not order tack/grooming stalls.
- Trainer/Entries with a minimum of 3 showing horses may order up to 2 tack/grooming stalls.
- Trainer/ Entries with more than 3 showing horses may order tack/ groomings stalls on a 1-3 basis.

(i.e. 3-6 showing horses can reserve up to 2 tack/ grooming stalls, 9 showing horses allows for 3 tack/ grooming stalls and so on.)

NIGHTWATCH

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or not, are required to pay a one time per show nightwatch fee of \$35.

This service is not optional. Safewatch LLC provides the nightwatch services for the Aiken Charity Horse Show.

MOTOR HOMES

A limited number of motor homes and camper sites are available. Please email: tara@aikenhorsepark.org prior to entering via www.horseshowsonline.com for information on camping areas/ \$325 weekly fee.

CREDIT CARD FEE

A credit card processing fee of 3.7% will be charged for payments made with a credit card to close out show bill.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES/GOLF CARTS

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and ay be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

MINOR EXHIBITORS

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above





described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

Protective head gear, properly secured, must be worn **BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED**, anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for all riders must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

TICKETED WARM-UP

For ticketed schooling please wear the show issued back number for your entry. One round of eight jumps is a \$40 charge per ticketed warm-up.

NON-SHOWING HORSES

All non-showing horses must complete an entry blank online and be assigned a back number. A \$150 fee will be assessed to any horse not entered in any classes.

PRIZE MONEY

The prize money recipient of any horse/pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded must provide a provide a W-9, W-8BEN, or W-8 certificate of foreign status form to the show office in order to receive prize money. Prize money will be credited to your show account. Any overages will be mailed within 30 days of check-out. In the event of unauthorized redeeming of a check Aiken Horse Park will provide check copies to exhibitors and will be held harmless from the collection process. Any checks not cashed with-in 180 days will be voided.

DOGS

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301. Failure to maintain your dog, under control, as defined here, will result in a \$100 fine assessed to the owner. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations, loose dogs will be removed by animal control, from the show grounds, at the owner's expense and impounded.

ANIMAL WELFARE

We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment.

Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not

present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

ELECTRICAL/FIRE REGULATIONS

All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

PARKING

Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. **PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNERS EXPENSE.**

REMINDER

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. RING SIZES

Jumper Ring: 250' x 350', Hunter 1 Ring: 150' x 300', Hunter 2 Ring: 150' x 300', Hunter 3 Ring: 150' x 300', Hunter 4 Ring: 150' x 300', Special Events Ring: 250' x 350'. All rings and warm ups are sand/poly-fiber mixture with GGT all weather footing.

BIOSECURITY PROTOCOLS

The Aiken Horse Park is dedicated to the health, welfare and safety of all exhibitors both equine and human. To protect our equine partners, we will be enforcing the following protocols at all the October at Bruce's Field horse shows. Please check our website for detailed plans.

It is advised that all horses stabling on the October at Bruce's Field show grounds arrive between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. If it is necessary to arrive at any other time you must check in with the stabling manager.

1. A current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test is required.
2. A Health Certificate must be signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at the October at Bruce's Field Show Grounds.
3. All horses must be accompanied by an Attestation of Health, please refer to the AHPF Statement of Health PDF download available at <https://aikenhorsepark.org>
4. Any horse on the show grounds with a fever of unknown origin or of suspicious origin must be reported to October at Bruce's Field Show Management and to the Show Veterinarian. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls will either be available on the grounds or at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.
5. Please take the time to review good equine hygiene practices. Please convey the importance of this to your equine caretakers for their daily routines. Aiken Horse Park strives to provide a safe and enjoyable show experience. An important part of that experience is maintaining healthy horses.

USEF GR845 EQUINE VACCINATION RULE

All horses stabling or competing at Bruce's Field must be accompanied by a Statement of Health. The Statement of Health must be signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days of arrival at the show grounds. The following horses meet the following health requirements:

At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

1. All horses are in compliance with vaccination requirements of USEF GR 844 and been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-4/1 with the most recent booster being within 180 days.
2. All horses have had temperature taken twice daily for the preceding 3 days and all temperatures were below 101.5 degrees Fahrenheit.
3. All horses have had no observable clinical signs of ill health such as nasal discharge, abnormal feces, abnormal gate or change in feed or water consumption.
4. All horses more than 7 months of age have documented evidence of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to the date of entering the competition stables.
5. Have NOT shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV- 4/1 within the past 28 days OR if the horse has tested positive for EHV-1 in the last 28 days it has subsequently had two negative EHV-1 PCR nasal swab tests 7 days apart in the prior 28 days.
6. Have NOT been exposed to any horses that have been treated for or show symptoms of EHV 1/4 within the past 28 days.
7. Horses have NOT been on any premises that have a suspected or confirmed case of Vesicular Stomatitis in the prior 14 days.

9. Does NOT originate from a premises under quarantine for an equine infectious disease.
10. A completed Statement of Health is required to be submitted for all horses upon arrival.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS

- To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.
- Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER, AND EQUITATION

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER, AND EQUITATION

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Sections offered and requirements:

- Adult Amateurs - may be split into three (3) sections

Cross Entry:

Rider

Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter classes may only show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. **Exception:** Riders competing in the Amateur Owner 3'3" section (but not competing in the Amateur Owner 3'6" section) may ride one horse that they do not own in the Adult Amateur Hunter section.

Adult Amateur Hunter Riders may cross enter into any Jumper Class 1.20m or below. Adult Amateur Hunter Riders may not cross enter into any Jumper class above 1.20m that offers prize money at the same show.

Horse

Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Fence Height

- 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- Courses will not be adjusted for ponies.
- In and outs will be permitted.

Combining/Dividing Sections

- Adult Amateurs 18- 35
- Adult Amateurs 36- 54
- Adult Amateurs 55 & over

The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in a section, that section must be combined with another Adult Amateur section. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Classics: Adult Amateur Hunter Classics

Four (4) entries are required to conduct an Adult Amateur Hunter Classic. If there are fewer than Four (4) entries in any one Adult Amateur Hunter Classic, it may combine with other sections of Adult Amateur Hunters or Children's Hunter Horse. If Adult Amateur Hunter Classics are combined and a horse is shown in more than one section qualifying for the Adult Amateur Hunter Classic, the exhibitor must declare their point section to the Competition Secretary on a declaration form at the time of entry into the Classic. Adult Amateur Hunter Classics cannot be divided in any manner and held by section if there are fewer than six (6) entries in each divided section.

LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Eligibility:

- Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

Cross Entry:

Rider

Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3" (**Exception:** Riders may cross enter all Equitation classes and Jumper Classes 1.15m and below). Riders who compete in the 3' Adult Hunters and/or the 3'3" Amateur Owner Hunter classes may show horses that they own in the Low Adult Hunters and one that they do not own in the Low Adult Hunters.

Horse & Rider Combination

Low Adult Amateur Hunter horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes or section where fences exceed 2'9".

Fence Height

- 2'6" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.

Combining/Dividing Sections

The Low Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Low Children's Hunter section when there are fewer than four (4) entries in either section. If sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both 1.00/1.05m and 1.10/1.15m are offered.

Fence Height

- Amateur Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m
- Amateur Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m

Combining/Dividing Sections

Junior Jumper sections may be divided by or combined with Amateur Jumper sections, at management's discretion, if so stated in the prize list.

Horse

Horses and ponies exhibited in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Fence Height

- 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height
- In and outs will be permitted

Combining/Dividing Sections

The Children's Hunter Horse section may be divided by age of rider. When the Children's Hunter Horse section is divided by age it will be divided: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under and Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either age section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. Alternatively, the Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Child Hunter Horse Classic:

Four (4) entries are required to conduct a Children's Hunter Horse Classic. If there are fewer than Four (4) entries in any one Children's Hunter Horse Classic, it may combine with other sections of Children's Hunter Horse or Adult Amateur Hunters. If the Children's Hunter Pony is divided by size it will be divided: Children's Hunter Pony Small/Medium and Children's Hunter Pony Large. **The Children's Hunter Pony section may be combined with Low Children's Hunter Pony when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section, or the Children's Hunter Pony may be combined with the Children's Hunter Horse section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.** When sections are combined **and** there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Low Children's Hunter Pony Riders may not cross enter into any class with fence heights that exceed 2'9" or into the Children's Hunter Pony, Pony Hunter, or Green Pony Hunter Section at the same competition.

Pony

Ponies exhibiting in Low Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR ALL HUNTER CLASSES

Hunter Over Fences: To be shown over approximately eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

Hunter Under Saddles: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. May be asked to hand gallop at the discretion of the judge but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales not permitted. Green and non-rated hunter sections will not be asked to gallop.

Model Class: To be shown at a walk and trot on the line; to be judged on conformation, way of moving and soundness.

Jog: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

Hunter Champion and Reserve Champion: To be awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences, in addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model.

Courses: Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop, and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as competition warrants. All Hunter divisions will be held in accordance with USEF Rules and Zone 4 Specifications. Hunter Sections with less than eight entries may be canceled or combined.

Presentations: First place ribbon winners of rated classes in the Main Hunter Ring will come to the presentation area.

Aiken Charity Horse Show ("Event") and USEF sanctioned or approved event(s) or activity(ies), including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions, and related or incidental activities related to or in preparation for the Event ("USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B.
