The 2025 recipient shall receive \$20,000. All applicants must be:

- Professional member in good standing with their respective national governing body
- US citizen or legal resident
- Demonstrate financial need
- Reside in Aiken, SC, for a minimum of 3 months annually
- Between the ages of 18 and 30 years of age by January 31st of application year

This grant is open to riders of all disciplines. The deadline to apply for the 2025 grant is **September 30th, 2024**.

The Annie Goodwin Rising Star Grant provides financial support for young professional equestrians establishing the early years of their business and wishing to continue their equestrian education and competition.
