## Winter 2019

#### Tuesdays in the Park

Schooling Days continued to be extremely popular especially among the winter eventing community. From January through March, each week was met with sold out divisions, even with the addition of a second jumper ring in February. The dressage schooling trips became increasingly popular as well, with notable leaders in the Aiken dressage community taking advantage of the schooling atmosphere.



#### Dressage

A growing number of Dressage riders are taking the opportunity to enjoy Bruce's Field. Dressage at Bruce's Field and Dressage in the Park were a part of the 2019 Aiken Dressage Challenge Series hosted in conjunction with Stable View. Each show featured exhibitors from Intro to Grand-Prix levels. The grace and beauty showcased in the sport was a treat for Bruce's Field and we look forward to the 2020 season in which we have added a third Dressage date in May following the conclusion of ACHS.

#### LiftMaster Grand-Prix Eventing at Bruce's Field

The most exciting addition to our 2019 calendar was undoubtably the inaugural \$50,000 LiftMaster Grand-Prix Eventing at Bruce's Field. This eventing showcase was the brainchild of US Olympic eventer, Phillip Dutton as a fitting tribute to Bruce's memory.

In every sense, our inaugural year was a smashing success! Top riders from around the world descended on Aiken to compete for their share of a \$50,000 purse. The field of international caliber boasted 11 Olympians, was

representative of 6 different countries, and included eventing legends such as William Fox-Pitt (GBR) and of course Phillip Dutton. On cross-country day alone close to 5,000 spectators poured onto Bruce's Field. The showcase format allowed spectators to be right up against the galloping lanes and feel the ground shake beneath their feet as horses and riders thundered past.









In addition the event hosted a craft beer festival during the cross-country phase and guests could stroll from fence to fence, through the vendor village with a tasty drink in hand. To date the livestream footage has been viewed over 13,000 times in different locations around the world. With the overwhelming success of the event's debut, the Aiken Horse Park Foundation is eagerly looking forward to and preparing for the 2020 \$50,000 LiftMaster Grand-Prix at Bruce's Field.

## Summer 2019

#### Equestrian Special Olympics

The Aiken Horse Park Foundation has had the immense privilege of hosting the South Carolina Equestrian Special Olympics for the past two years. Fondly known as the "Happiest Horse Show", the Equestrian Special Olympics perfectly embodies Bruce's vision of encouraging the Aiken community's civic, educational, and charitable endeavors. One only needs to spend a few minutes observing these inspiring athletes to experience the sportsmanship and camaraderie of the event. The two-day long competition included the celebrated opening ceremonies, complete with the parade of athletes, lighting of the torch, and the Star-Spangled Banner performed by one of the athletes. Family and friends along with the local community filled the spectator tent all weekend long.



#### Aiken Summer Classic

In June we were pleased to welcome Bob Bell's Aiken Summer Classic Horse Shows to Bruce's Field. Their Summer Series, traditionally held at the Georgia International Horse Park, made the move to Aiken for Bruce's Field's famed footing and hospitality. To our welcome surprise, all 600 stalls including 376 temporary stalls initially erected for the Aiken Charity Horse Shows, were completely sold out. The Classic Company had an incredibly successful debut in Aiken and we look forward to hosting them again in the future.



### Fall 2019

#### Equus Events Fall Festival

From the first horse show held at Bruce's Field, Equus Events has been a partner and supporter of the Aiken Horse Park Foundation. Throughout the year Equus presented a series of events over the horse show season (Aiken Winter Premier, Aiken Winter Finale, & December Classic), not to mention a sold-out Aiken Fall Festival. JP Godard and his team execute the quality of events we are proud to host and have attracted some of the top riders in the country.



#### Young Horse Show

Another first for Aiken, Bruce's Field was the sight of the inaugural Aiken Young Horse Show in October. The Young Horse Show Series is a non-discipline specific opportunity for horses from ages 1 to 5 to compete in over fences, flat, and in-hand classes. The highlight of the competition is the jump chute where horses are at liberty and are driven through a line of three jumping efforts. This allows judges to see a horse's natural jumping ability without the interference from a rider and tack. The organizers remarked that every horse they saw was of excellent quality and Bruce's Field was a tier-above venue that truly gave the youngsters a well-rounded show experience. The Aiken Young Horse Show was the last qualifying event for the Young Horse Show Series Finals, held at the Tryon International Equestrian Center, November 9th and 10th. The Aiken Horse Park Foundation is extremely proud to have brought this new event to Aiken and we look forward to seeing it grow in the future.
