In 2000, Bruce Duchossois bought the beautiful 66 acre track of land, now known as Bruce's Field, to save it from development. In doing so, he helped preserve the sport of steeplechasing in Aiken and provided for a spectacular venue to hold the type of horse shows he cherished. Shows that were exhibitor friendly, had loads of hospitality, and gave back to his beloved community of Aiken.

Sadly, he did not live to see his dream to fruition, but we are confident in knowing he is watching down and smiling, seeing his friends enjoying themselves, and the bright future that lies ahead for Aiken's Equestrian community.
