Athletics at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic School are to support and exemplify our mission statements and philosophy. In upholding these values our school has instituted an "Open Participation" policy. All students currently enrolled in grades 5-8 are eligible to participate in athletics This policy allows for any qualifying student to join any athletic program. This policy, however, does not guarantee equal playing time for every participant. Participation in games is based on effort, attitude, and attendance per the coach's discretion. The athletic program strives to allow everyone to participate in games when applicable. Our purpose is to be competitive while providing an opportunity for overall participation.

As our school continues to grow we also understand the need for more then one team per class. Dual teams will be assigned depending on the amount of players who sign up and available coaches. If dual teams are made they will be split up equally ensuring varied skill levels on both teams. A and B teams will not be made and students will not be cut. However, standards will be set high for student participation. Good coaches and programs help students develop discipline, place others before self, and handle both joy and disappointments with grace and a generous spirit. We ask these things of our student athletes:

- A 70 percent grade average in every subject must be maintained in order to participate in extracurricular activities. Students must maintain required attendance, academic, and conduct standards in order to participate.
- To represent their school, their team and them selves with dignity and class.
- To be committed to the team and their teammates. Athletes are expected to make all practices, work hard, take constructive criticism from their coaches and put the team before individual statistics or success.
