Roles and Responsibilities:

This position will work with farmers and landowners to provide technical guidance in the overall planning, design, installation, and maintenance of the engineering phases of soil and water conservation practices.

- Provides technical assistance in the planning, design, and construction of engineering practices such
 as water management (i.e. drop box, underground outlet, roof runoff structure), animal waste
 management (i.e. waste transfer pipe, manure stacking pad, barnyard collection), and erosion control
 (i.e. stream crossing, access road, grassed waterway)
- Plans and conducts pre-construction meetings, monitors work for compliance with approved designs, and executes quality assurance program
- Prepares or reviews field designs and preliminary and final drawings and specifications on various agricultural/civil engineering practices (i.e. stormwater management plans, erosion & sediment control plans)
- Performs infiltration testing, assists with topographic surveys, and prepares permitting packages (i.e. NPDES and Chapter 105)

Qualifications:

- College-level engineering degree accredited by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) as a professional engineering curriculum
- Training and technical experience that has provided a thorough knowledge of physical and mathematical sciences underlying engineering
- Experience working with the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) is preferred;
 specifically, with the Engineering Field Tools (EFT), Field Office Technical Guide (FOTG), and
 Conservation Practice Standards

- Proficient using AutoCAD software
- Valid Driver's License & Appropriate Vehicle (Adequate Space for Field Equipment)
- Familiarity with PA DEP Chapter 102 and 91 Regulations
- Knowledge of County Conservation Districts, Townships, and Non-Profit Watershed Organizations
- Maintains or is working toward an Engineering-In-Training (EIT) License and Certification
