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PROOF OF AGE DOCUMENT

An application for pension benefits must have a proof of age document. The Fund Office would request a birth certificate (issued from the Department of Health) be furnished with the application.

For those cases where a birth certificate (issued from the Department of Health) cannot be furnished, then proof of date of birth may be provided to the Board of Trustees by replacing the birth certificate with one of the documents listed below:

- 1. Valid driver's license or state issued identification card
- 2. Passport and date issued
- 3. DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty
- 4. Form 2458 from Social Security Administration advising date of birth they used in order to award benefits
- 5. Naturalization papers and date issued

If you cannot furnish one of the above-requested documents, please contact the Fund Office for assistance.

The Fund Office reserves the right to request, inspect and copy an original, certified copy or notarized copy of the furnished document(s).
