- 2) Club meetings would be held the first Tuesday of every month.
- 3) Campouts would be scheduled for the second weekend of the month.

November 9 - 11, 1979

Four families drove their rigs to Shingletown to join the First Hosts in a fun filled weekend among the trees.

An IDEA becomes reality

Between November 1979 and November 1980 The first officers of the Club were elected. The Club's name & logo were adopted. A campouts occurred every month. Publication of the Club Newsletter began. The Club By-Laws were adopted. The Club's membership increased.

November 7 - 9, 1980

First Anniversary Campout - Oak Bottom area at Whiskeytown Lake. There were 12 rigs out of a membership of 34 rigs present to share this celebration. A special cake was prepared to mark this event.
