Don't you love the new handicap parking spaces in front of the hall? The concrete with blue makings really stands out and the soon to be fresh asphalt sealing will finish the entrance way. (As a FYI – The city of Arnold, when we remodeled the bathrooms, required that we bring the handicapped parking area up to ADA standards – hence the perfectly flat, concrete and larger spaces with van accessibility.) If you must do it, might as well put a happy face on it, I say.

Our own Rich Tourville is getting ready to refinish the front concrete stairs and we will soon be calling for a workday to paint all the railings. In addition to the front stairs Rich is rebuilding the retaining wall next to the back door with concrete and filling and sealing the gap between the back wall and parking lot.

The walk-in cooler, which has served us for almost 30 years, finally gave up the ghost, so we had to order a new cooling system which should be installed in the next 2 weeks. Hey, nothing lasts forever. Along with sealing the front part of the parking lot the Board decided to reseal the rear parking lot, leaving the driveway and large lot to be sealed probably next year.

All our upstairs offices are currently rented, and we have a short waiting list. Wow, that isn't something we've seen in a long time.

A special thanks to Tom Deddens and Rich Lifka for their hard work in getting the offices cleaned, painted and ready to rent. Based on our yearly budget projections we expect our rental income to exceed expenses by approximately \$22,000, add \$5,000 for renting our parking lot for fireworks, add some hall rentals and our finances are looking pretty good.


