Adults categories

1. Produce

- 1.1- Jam or preserve: using shop bought or home grown fruit of any flavour. Must be made at home with a spreadable consistency.
- 1.2- Any fruit or vegetable that has been grown at home in a garden, allotment, balcony or windowsill! Will be judged on size and appearance not taste.

2. Baking

- 2.1- Cakes
 - 2.2- Biscuits
 - 2.3- Bread
 - 2.4- Misc baked goods that don't fit into previous categories.
- All items in this group will be judged on taste and appearance.

3. Flowers

A flower arrangement presented in a jam jar. You can use home grown or shop bought flowers.

4. Creative

- 4.1- Knitting or crochet
- 4.2- Embroidery or cross stitch
- 4.3- Poetry, an original poem on any theme. Max 1 side of A4.

5. Photography

A photograph taken on any device (i.e. camera, polaroid, smartphone) on the theme of community. A hard copy should be submitted with your name on the reverse. Does not have to be taken in Swansea but should reflect the theme.

Childrens categories

Children's categories are open to anyone under the age of 16. Please include your age on your submission form. Where there are sufficient entries we will endeavour to split the age groups further.

1. Produce

Any fruit, vegetable or plant that has been grown at home in a garden, allotment, balcony or windowsill! Will be judged on size and appearance.

2. Baking

Any cake, biscuits, bread or other baked goods. Should be made without parents help. All items in this group will be judged on taste and appearance.

3. Nature

3.1- An animal made from fruit or vegetables. Other materials can be used for construction, but the main elements should be natural.

3.2- The smallest shell. Shells must be intact.

4. Creative

4.1- Decorate a coconut, turn it into whatever character you want!

4.2- Picture- any medium, on whatever theme you like.

4.3- Poetry, an original poem on any theme. Max 1 side of A4.

5. Photography

A photograph taken on any device (i.e. camera, polaroid, smartphone) on the theme of community. A hard copy should be submitted with your name on the reverse. Does not have to be taken in Swansea but should reflect the theme.
