Instructions for Completing ASNA College Scholarship Application

1. Send **three (3) complete sets** of application materials to Education Committee Chairman **on or before the DEADLINE**. (One copy shall be kept on file by the Chairman; other copies are sent to committee members for review.)
2. Application materials shall be compiled in the following order:
 - A. Application Form
 - B. A personal letter stating plans for professional development and reasons for requesting financial aid
 - C. An official transcript from each educational institution attended. (One original and the other can be copies)
 - D. A degree plan/course checklist from the institution in which applicant plans to enroll.
 - E. Letters of recommendation from:
 1. Dean of school or major professor in planned program
 2. A member of faculty, supervisor, director or employer
 3. One other professional person

Letters of recommendation should include the following information: capacity in which applicant has been known, length of time applicant has been known, personality, ability, initiative, potential as a professional person, and financial status.

3. The following criteria will be used when judging applications:
 - A. Professional potential
 - B. Letter pertaining to academic professional plans
 - C. Financial need
 - D. ASNA membership

Undergraduate scholarship is worth \$1,000, to be paid in two installments of \$500 each.
Graduate scholarship is worth \$2,000, to be paid in two installments of \$1,000.
