**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING TO REMOVE SNOW ON ALL
STREETS IN THE TOWN OF SENECA, CRAWFORD, WISCONSIN**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca has determined the need for alternate side parking for the purpose of snow removal during winter months.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties pursuant to WI. Statutes, chapter 346-349 and/or by its adoption of village powers under Sec. 60.10 WI. Statutes; to regulate, control, prevent and enforce against and operations by persons that may effect the alternate side parking ordinance in the Town of Seneca.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF SENECA, CRAWFORD COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide a system of alternate side parking giving the date, time and what side of the street vehicles will be allowed to park on during winter months for snow removal. This system will also provide a means of swift snow removal by removing all obstacles that obstruct the snow removal process.

Section 2: BOUNDARIES AND AREA

The Town of Seneca established by this ordinance the following area marked by the Town of Seneca by traffic signs a "Alternate Side Parking" area in the Town of Seneca, Hwy 27/Main Street

Section 3: PROCEDURE


- a. In this area marked by the Town of Seneca, Alternate Side Parking will be in effect from November 15 to April 1.
- b. During this period parking on odd numbered calendar days will be on the west side of the streets (odd house numbers). On even numbered calendar days parking will be on the east side of the streets (even house numbers).
- c. During this period alternate side parking will be from 12:01 a.m. – 7:00 a.m.
- d. In this area marking by the Town of Seneca, alternate side parking signs as noted in WI State Statutes Sec. 346.53-346-55, upon any portion of a highway or street where and at the time when parking is prohibited, limited or restricted by official traffic signs, no person shall stop, or leave any vehicle standing on that side of the street except temporarily for the purpose of discharging passengers and while a vehicle is attended by a licensed operator so that it can be moved in case of an emergency or to avoid obstruction.


SECTION 4: PENALTY


Penalty for violating the alternate side parking ordinance may be a forfeiture. A citation may be issued by the Crawford County Sheriff's Department for habitual violation. Towing will be at the owners expense.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as required by law.

Town of Seneca
Snow and Ice Removal Ordinance
Amended: 10/9/2014

A. Removal from sidewalks

- (1) The owner, occupant or person in charge of any parcel or lot which fronts upon or abuts any sidewalk within the Seneca Sanitary District shall keep said sidewalk clear of all snow, ice, dirt and rubbish of any kind. In the event of snow accumulating on said sidewalk due to natural means and/or by any other means, said sidewalks shall be cleared of all accumulated snow and/or ice within 24 hours from the time the snow ceases to accumulate on said sidewalk. It is unlawful to shovel or push snow on public roads. In the event that ice has formed on any sidewalk in such a manner that it cannot be removed, the owner, occupant or person in charge of the parcel or lot, which front upon or adjoins said sidewalk shall keep the sidewalk sprinkled with material to accelerate melting or prevent slipping.
- (2) If snow is not cleaned within 48 hours from the time snow ceases, owner will be billed for removal. Habitual offenders may be cited by Crawford County Sheriff's Department.
