Ordinance Number # 01-2023 ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON TOWN ROAD

STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF SENECA **CRAWFORD COUNTY**

The Town Board of the Town of Seneca, Crawford County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., effective May 1, 2023, the speed limit on certain Town of Seneca roads are reduced or modified as follows: The speed limit on Lucky Lane from the woods to the end of the road shall be reduced to 25 mph.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. Stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town road in violation of the above-noted speed limit. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance shall become effective on May 1, 2023.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
