Porsena's First Project

This project is dear to our hearts in so many ways: In early 2025, months after Porsena was established, it was called to support the Shalom Foundation and the Moore Pediatric Surgery Center in Guatemala City (GT).

Guatemala City has unique threats to prepare for, and the Moore Pediatric Surgery Center is no different.

Prior to deploying to Guatemala City, Porsena worked with the Shalom Foundation to understand the key objectives of the Moore Pediatric Surgery Center, and how to balance a welcoming environment, high-quality services, and protecting those it serves; and personnel it brings in to support its operations.

Porsena spent time with leadership and staff at the Moore Pediatric Surgery Center to understand the dynamics, operations, and concerns as it developed a security and threat assessment analysis to support continued improvement.

The analysis provided a spectrum of planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise proposals to support operations within the Moore Pediatric Surgery Center, as well as its operations across Guatemala.
