You should always assume they are doing their very best.

REFFING ASSIGNMENT

Each team will be required to supply one score keeper, one score flipper, two lines people, and one adult referee. Please bring a whistle. Scorekeepers and line judges should not be on their phones. No headphones in while reffing as well.
