



Pool play - 2 games to 25, 27-point cap or 40 minutes, do not end on a tie, no timeouts after 3 minutes remaining. Whichever comes first; 10-minute shared warm-up for the first 2 rounds. 5 minutes for the remainder of the rounds. Warm up clocks will start immediately after rounds end so please move to your courts quickly. Middle school main gym courts must wait to warm up until the neighbor court is finished.

\*All times are approximate. We will start rounds early whenever possible. Coaches, please keep your courts moving.

## SPECTATORS

All cheers, comments and actions shall be in direct support of one's team. No cheers, comments or actions shall be directed at one's opponent or at contest officials. Some examples of unacceptable conduct include but are not limited to: disrespecting players by name, number or position; negative cheers or chants; throwing objects on the playing surface; use of derogatory or racially explicit language; discriminatory harassment or conduct that creates a hostile environment that is disruptive to the playing environment. Please refrain from speaking with or yelling at the line judges and score table. If there is an issue, approach your coach. Please remember that these kids are 12-14 years old. You should always assume they are doing their very best. Continuous negative behavior from coaches, teams or spectators will receive a warning. If warnings do not work, we will remove spectators from the tournament and the teams they belong to from future tournaments.

## REFFING ASSIGNMENT

Each team will be required to supply one score keeper, one score flipper, two lines people, and one adult referee. Please bring a whistle. Scorekeepers and line judges should not be on their phones or have head phones in. Please also do not

allow kids to have open or spillable drinks at ref tables or benches. Encourage them to pick up their trash in these areas as well.

## REFFING/GAME PLAY:

We will not have adjusted serving lines for 14U and will call foot faults. When bracket play begins, if all teams in lower bracket need adjustments, we will accommodate.

Please call big nets and ball handling errors. Safety is of utmost importance, but we would like to encourage lots of play. If in middle school main gym, if a team runs into the other court, they are out.

We do no track rotations but try your best to abide by legal substitutions and rotations.

Encourage servers to hustle back to endline and not have a 30 second preserve routine.

Only one drop toss while serving per rotation.

## Facility Use:

If you have played at the Middle School, you know it gets very crowded. Please encourage your parents, players and spectators to leave their seats if their child is not playing. We only have 2 tournaments at this location this year and I want to make it as smooth as possible.
