

COVC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION

COVC works hard to provide scholarships opportunities for many athletes in Central Oregon. COVC is revamping the scholarship program for this season! This season COVC is going to partner with athletes and parents and do the work together!

COVC athletes and parents are offered the opportunity to work local tournaments to offset the cost of their tuition. Each local tournament we pay \$200 for players to work tournaments, if a parent & player sign up payment is \$400 towards tuition. Once tuition obligations are filled players may elect to take payment for their work. Please note, these opportunities fill up quickly. Expectations include, arriving at required time to set up equipment, score tables, collecting door fees etc. Walking though and checking bleachers, bathrooms & halls for clean up or supplies. Recording scores after each match and running efficiently. After tournament take down equipment, clean gym and food areas. Roughly 7-9 shift. All 8th grade & under workers require a parent. High Schoolers do not.

Working at Skills Clinics. Opportunity for High School players and/or parents. During season we offer some during Christmas Break and other times throughout the season. Players can reach out on a first come first serve basis. Clinics pay by the hour. Sign up quickly as paid spots fill up quickly.

Helping coaches at practices – offered to 8th grade and High School players. 8th graders can help with 12u, and High Schoolers can assist with 12s and 14s practices. Contact Club Director Heidi Wood 541 460 1283 for information. This opportunity is paid by the hour.

Coaching a local's team – seniors and juniors who are approved can coach a local's team and receive payment. Fundraising – COVC does a Butter Braid fundraiser, profits from sales can be applied to your tuition.
