#### **New Business:**

- 1. Conceptual agreement of loan Attorney Jeff McInnis has not completed the resolution to approve loan for additional financing for Station 44, so a special meeting needs to be held at a later date. Date was set for Tuesday, July 9, 2024, at 6 pm. Dee will send a notice to the paper.
- **2. Bond counsel** We were able to get the bond counsel cost down to approximately \$15k. We can use the first drawdown from the loan to pay it off.
- **3. FY 2025 Budget/Statutory increase** Increase was 7.48% this year, which will add an additional \$242k to next year's budget. The budget will be ready to discuss and review in August.
- 4. Approval to request new apparatus build The build time for all engines now is roughly 40 months, almost 4 years. The Pierce engines are now 6 years old and will need to be replaced by the time one is built. Chief Lewis would like approval to get one spec'd out and on order. Payment is due when apparatus is received. Commissioner Culberson made a motion to approve getting a new engine on order, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Reilly. Vote held. Motion passed unanimous.
