

HOLLEY NAVARRE FIRE DISTRICT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

GOAL/OBJECTIVE 1- IMPROVE COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Response time less than 6 minutes district wide.
- Contain structure fires to the room of origin 80% of the time.
- Zero civilian fire deaths.
- Water on the fire within 5 minutes 90% of the time.
- Primary search completed within 5 minutes 90% of the time.

GOAL/OBJECTIVE 2 – IMPROVE FIREFIGHTER SAFETY

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Zero firefighter line of duty deaths.
- Maintain injury rate below 10% of the total staffing positions.
- Completion of 95% of assigned training annually.
- Conduct post fire decontamination 100% of the time.
- Development of a wellness / fitness initiative.

GOAL/OBJECTIVE 3 – MAXIMIZE BUDGET AND VALUE TO THE COMMUNITY

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Zero cases of employee litigation.
- Maintain a “cost per capita” equal to or below the regional average.
- Achieve and maintain an ISO rating of class 3.
- Save 95% of the value of property and contents threatened by fire.

GOAL/OBJECTIVE 4 – IMPROVE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE COMMUNITY & PROVIDE VALUE BEYOND EMERGENCY SERVICES

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Inspect all commercial structures per Florida fire code/enforcement.
- Develop and implement a program to assist the community after a building fire.
- Provide fire safety programs for all kindergarten students.
- Develop and implement senior citizen safety programs.
- Develop and maintain a culture of pride, ownership and engagement.

GOAL/OBJECTIVE 5 – IMPROVE INTERNAL OPERATIONS OF THE HOLLEY NAVARRE FIRE DISTRICT

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Improve internal communications.
- Improve / maintain a good public perception.
- Improve customer service.
- Improve the quality of training.
- Enhance promotional testing.
- Improve officer development.

GOAL/OBJECTIVE 6 – IMPROVE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY ALL – HAZARDS APPROACH TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- Foster a community wide culture of preparedness.
- Reduce district-wide risk and enhance prevention capabilities.
- Continue to enhance delivery of technical rescue services.
- Ensure district wide emergency management capabilities through training and exercises.
- Strengthen response capabilities using technology, collaborative partnerships, community support.
