FRIGHT NIGHTS

BONFIRE Night is upon us, and it's important to remember it can be a frightening time for our four-legged friends.

About 45% of pooches find the bangs and brightness of fireworks distressing. Grain-free pet food specialist Carapet explains this is because, like wild animals, dogs associate loud noises and unexpected bangs with danger.

They also possess an acute sense of hearing. Jenna Kiddin, at Dogs' Trust, says: 'Dogs have approximately four times more sensitive hearing than humans, so the loud cracks and bangs of

fireworks can often be a terrifying and confusing experience for them.'

During this stressful period, vet John Burns, is urging owners to take steps to their pets feel as safe and relaxed as possible.

Make a safe space for them to relax in, give them a treat dispenser or long-lasting chew to keep them busy and turn up the TV to mask the sound of the bangs.

I'd also recommend taking your dog for a long walk in the day to tire them out, as well as to avoid after-dark firework displays.
